
# STEM at home

These activities are meant to introduce children ages 2-10 to basic STEM concepts.






#### Development and Construction

Geotechnical (soil) engineers use science and math to design retaining walls and foundations to support buildings.






Energy (Electricity)

Scientists and engineers evaluate how new power lines could impact plants, animals and slopes, helping utility companies decide where to build so we can have electricity.






#### Trenchless Pipelines

Engineers design different methods to safely install pipes under rivers, lakes, highways and buildings to lessen the impact to above ground activities and environments.



## Let's Rock!


Find 5 rocks in your yard or garden.


